



From June 13th to June 16th, 2025, the Center for Strategic Politics and the DREAM campaign conducted an English-language survey of 580 likely Democratic voters in New York City using random device engagement through Pollfish. Respondents outside the sampled population were screened by self-identification. The sample was weighted to be representative of the projected electorate for the June 24th, 2025 Democratic primary with respect to age, ethnicity, gender, and borough. The margin of error is  $\pm 4.07\%$ .

Ideological leaning reflected in results is based on self-reported ideology, where Liberal is a combination of Liberal and Socialist responses, and Conservative is a combination of Conservative and Libertarian responses.

A Staten Island crosstab is not presented due to low sample size.
