



On August 5th, 2026, the Center for Strategic Politics conducted an English-language survey of 403 likely Democratic voters in Florida’s 25th Congressional District using SMS to collect web responses. Respondents outside the sampled population were screened by self-identification and voter file match. The sample was weighted to be representative of likely Democratic primary voters by age, race, gender, geography, and education. The margin of error is $\pm 4.87\%$. This survey was commissioned by Oliver for Congress.

The **Voted** crosstab consists of respondents who reported having already voted, either early in-person or by mail. The **Not Voted** crosstab consists of respondents who did not report having already voted.

Crosstabs for demographic sub-groups with insufficiently high sample sizes have been omitted.
